Introduction :

Pravara Medical Trust, Ahmednagar had submitted a proposal for starting a Physiotherapy College in its institution Pravara Gramin Medical College, Loni, Tah. Shrirampur, Distt. Ahmednagar. Pune University has conveyed its approval vide letter No. RA/A/29/96-97/2110 dated 22.8.1996 to the aforesaid institution for starting physiotherapy College and admission of students to 1st year of the course from the session 1996-97. Director, Medical Education and Research has recommended grant of recognition to proposed physiotherapy College of Pravara Medical Trust, Loni, Distt. Ahmednagar. Grant of recognition to proposed physiotherapy College from ensuing academic session was under consideration of the Government.

Govt. Order :

On considering recommendation of Pune University to start physiotherapy College by institution Pravara Gramin Medical College, Loni Teh. Shrirampur, Dist. Ahmednagar of Pravara Medical Trust, Ahmednagar the Government has granted recognition from academic year 1996-97. This recognition is subject to conditions prescribed in enclosed Appendix-A.

2. Admission to this college will be regulated under the authority of Director, Medical Education & Research.

3. This Govt. Order is issued with the concurrence of Deptt. of Higher & Technical Education.

APPENDIX -A

1. At present recognition for 3 years on adhoc basis is being granted. Subsequently, for every year extension of recognition will be considered after inspection.
2. College admission capacity will be 50.
3. Admission to Vaidyakiya Mahavidyalaya will be in accordance with the scheme laid by Supreme Court in Writ Petition No. 607/92- J. Unnikrishnan Vs. Govt. of AP.
4. Rules and regulation laid by State Govt. for Physiotherapy colleges will be binding on the Institution.
5. Institution will strictly comply with the provisions of Maharashtra Education Institutions (Prohibition of capitation Fees) Act, 1987 (Maharashtra Act 6 of 1988).
6. Institution should give an undertaking that it will not demand any grant from the Government for recurring / non-recurring expenditure.
7. In accordance with the decision of Nagpur University for all the Physiotherapy colleges in the State towards harmony the duration of this course will be 4¹/₂ years. The concerned Institution should pursue the matter with Pune University for recognition and only thereafter the college started by the institution will remain recognized by the Govt.
