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09 Nursing students from University of Worcester, UK visited Smt. SEVP College of Nursing from 31st July 2023 to 04th August 2023. The details of the visit are as follows:

Day 1 (31.07.23) - Program Co-ordinator Ms. Rubina Cambell, Assistant Professor, Smt. SEVP College of Nursing received the students from NRI hostel on 31st July 2023 at 09:15 am. Students were welcomed at Smt. SEVP College of Nursing by the Principal & teaching faculty. Initially, Prof. Dr. Rajendra D. Lamkhede, Principal, Smt. SEVP College of Nursing addressed the Students and gave an overview of establishment of Smt. SEVP College of Nursing and various courses offered. After Principal's address, Students were oriented with the college infrastructure, classrooms, laboratories and other departments of college. After orientation, a brief Faculty interaction was carried out, where Smt. SEVP College of Nursing teaching faculty and International students introduced themselves to each other. SEVP College of Nursing, demonstrated a basic nursing procedure of 'Bandaging' from Nursing Foundation subject. The Day 1 schedule ended with question and answer and feedback session, all the doubts and question of students were clarified by the respective faculty. Students departed at 5.00pm.









Day 2 (01.08.23) - Students reported to Smt. SEVP College of Nursing at 9:15 am sharp. Students attended a presentation from 9:15am to 11:00 am where Prof. Dr. Heera Jayasheela presented a lecture on 'Nursing Education in India'. After a break of 15 mins, Dr. Kalpana Kale, Asso. Day 3 (02.08.23) – After reporting to Smt. SEVP College of Nursing at 9:15 am sharp, students were taken to Community health nursing laboratory, where Dr. Kalpana Kale discussed about the Concept of Home-visit and demonstrated Bag Technique to them. After a break of 10 mins, students were taken to ZP School, Pravaranagar, by Mrs. Sandnya Gawade to show them the concept of Child-to-

Child program, where a student from Fourth year BSc. Nursing Mr. Akash Pawar gave health education to students of Standard 4 on 'Personal Hygiene', and then those students passed the same health information to other students. Students were then taken for a visit to UPHC at Pravaranagar and RPHC at Kolhar. Students then departed for lunch. After lunch break, the students were taken to Obstetrics and Gynaecology areas by Mrs. Sonali Kashid, Tutor/CI, Smt. SEVP College of Nursing and were given orientation to Labour room, PNC unit and also explained the concept of Partograph. Mrs. Swapnali Kapse demonstrated an obstetrical procedure on 'ANC assessment'. Students departed at 5.00pm after a brief question and answer and feedback session.
