



WORLD PHYSIOTHERAPY DAY 2023

Organized by IQAC and Community Extension Activity Committee Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam College of Physiotherapy **Department of Orthopaedic Physiotherapy**, Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam College of Physiotherapy had organized a **Quiz Competition** on 8thSeptember 2023 on the occasion of World Physiotherapy Day. Total **20**students participated in the competition, rules and guidelines were provided prior to the competition to the students and were asked to prepare poster accordingly. Students were then judged on basis of their knowledge of the topic.

Department of Cardiorespiratory Physiotherapy has organized a guest lecture on physiotherapy awareness as a career choice for 12th class (science) students of PVP Jr college Loni on 7th **September**, 10am onwards. Total 600 students attended the lecture. 2nd year MPT students delivered a speech along with Dr. Aashirwad Mahajan on awareness about the importance of physiotherapy, how to get admission in physiotherapy institutes and a list of known physiotherapy institutes, and criteria for admission, future scope and job opportunities in India as well as abroad.





Department of Community Physiotherapy, Better Management of Osteoarthritis (BOA) Unit, and IQAC, Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam College of Physiotherapy organized Arthritis Screening camp for Employees and Residents of PMT Campus from 4th September to 8th September 2023. As most of the employee desk job workers and peons work in continuous sitting, squatting, and lifting heavy load, all these positions have been associated with increased arthritis risk. Total 130 individuals were assessed and were given ergonomic advice during the camp by adapting some minor changes in their workplace.



Department of Community Physiotherapy, Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam COPT had organised Skit Play depicting "Awareness on Arthritis" at Gram Panchayat, Loni on 4th September 2023. Skit was organized to educate general population regarding different form of Arthritis and to equip them with the knowledge and skill to manage their disease to allow maximum lifestyle flexibility.





Department of Community Physiotherapy, Dr. APJ Abdul Kalam COPT had organized a "Fall Risk Screening Camp for Geriatrics Individuals residing in PMT Campus" from 4th September to 8th September 2023. Geriatrics individuals have more risk of fall with advancing age. Fall is major threat to older adults, as fall related injuries may lead to loss of independence and reduced quality of life, often causing a decline in self-care ability and participation in physical and social activities. Total 29 individuals were screened during the camp and 20% of Geriatric population showed moderate risk of fall.





Department of Pediatric Physiotherapy, Dr APJ Abdul Kalam COPT organized lecture on " Posture and Exercises for School Children" at Pravara Girls English Medium School, Loni. 450 Students attended and enthusiastically participated in the activity. The students were explained about various postural abnormalities and exercises to prevent them along with demonstrations
