Title: Fellowship in Phacoemulsification Surgery

Introduction:Cataract is a common cause of blindness in general population. The incidence is very high almost more than 80% in population above 60 years. Cataract is defined as any opacity in the lens or capsule. There is no medical treatment and surgery is the only treatment. Phacoemulsification is one of the major innovations of the 21st century. The cataract surgery is not only vision restoration but also a refractive surgery. The advances in optical designs and phacoemulsification surgery has revolutionized the cataract management giving post-operative emmetropia and good visual rehabilitation. The resident in his PG training do not get much exposure to Phacoemulsification surgery. This short term fellowship of 6 months will add to their clinical and surgical skills.

- **Objectives:** 1. a) To be fully oriented to Phacodynamics and Phaco machine functioning.
 - b) To do proper pre operative cataract evaluation and biometry
 - c) To acquire surgical skills to perform Phacoemulsification surgery independently.
 - 2. Surgical Skills:
 - a) The candidate will acquire ability to perform Phacoemulsification surgery.
 - b) He will also be able to manage complication if any during the surgery on in post Operation period.

3. Duration: One Year

4. Eliglibility: M. S. / D. N. B. / D. O. - Ophthalmology

5. Intake Capacity: Two Student per Year

6. Proposed Tuition Fee: Rs. 30,000 for the course
